Please join us in celebrating our 86th year of holding Charity Balls to raise funds for organizations serving children and teens in Fairfield County.

- Members of the Class of 2025 accompanied by a guest (i) enrolled in a public high school in the participating towns of Easton, Fairfield, Redding, Weston, Westport and Wilton, (the "Member Towns") or (ii) who are a resident of a Member Town attending another high school, are invited to register for the date specified for their town.
- This invitation and the resulting attendance are non-transferable and **non-refundable**.
- Registration price: \$195 for two to attend the Charity Ball.
- Each main registrant shall invite and be accompanied by a guest.
- **Registration opens: Sunday, October 29, 2023** and is online via our website: www.thecountyassemblies.org.
- **RSVP Due Date: Registration will close on Sunday, November 19, 2023.** Online registration, including a signed Informed Consent and Waiver, contact information and accepted payment must be completed by the RSVP Due Date. *No attendees will be accepted after this date.*
- Please be advised that, in addition to online registration and payment by the main registrant and the main registrant's parent, the guest and the guest's parent must complete the online registration for the guest to attend, via our website, by providing us with emergency contact information and signing an Informed Consent and Waiver, for the registration to be complete. No payment is requested of the guest. An automatic email confirmation will be sent to the main registrant's email address provided during registration. If you do not receive this email, you are **NOT REGISTERED**.
- If a main registrant changes their guest prior to or after the close of registration, registrant must delete their old guest's information, and add their new guest and send a new request for Informed Consent to the new guest and the new guest's parent via our website. If main registrant changes their guest after the close of registration, main registrant must also notify The County Assemblies via email at: registrar@thecountyassemblies.org and include the school main registrant attends and the name of the new guest. An Informed Consent and Waiver must be completed by the new guest and the new guest's parent on our website or admittance to the Ball will be denied.
- The County Assemblies' ZERO Drug, Alcohol Tolerance and E-Cigarette/Vaping Policy will be strictly enforced.
- No one will be admitted after 8:30pm or permitted to leave prior to 10:30pm, unless permission has been granted in advance by the Board.

The Snow Date can be used for any reason the Board deems, in its sole discretion, necessary or advisable.
