- Please be advised that, in addition to online registration and payment by the main registrant and the main registrant's parent, the guest and the guest's parent must complete the online registration for the guest to attend, via our website, by providing us with emergency contact information and signing an Informed Consent and Waiver, for the registration to be complete.
